This updated Italian Position Paper (SIPMO-SICMF) on Medication-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (MRONJ) covers a comprehensive overview of current knowledge on the topic.

It includes a detailed workflow for the disease diagnosis and clinical management, based on the reasoned combination of clinical evaluations and radiological exams.

The Authors describe the complexity of care for MRONJ patients, taking into account the management of the frequent comorbidities and suggesting the indications to improve the appropriateness of surgical and medical strategies.

With regard to prevention, the Panel promotes clear recommendations to assess a multivariate model of risk-patient stratification.

The Position paper suggests patient tailored treatment, starting with perioperative antibiotic administration, followed by specific surgical an/or not surgical protocols and maintenance schedules.

Overall, the work carried out by the Italian Authors provides a useful concise and clear approach to MRONJ, going beyond dogmatic positions related to the case definition and clinical management,
