The literature study should 1. examine how consumer cooperatives affect members' livelihoods. 2. Describe how consumer cooperatives use specific procedures to improve members' livelihoods, taking into account local circumstances.

3. How do consumer cooperatives support members' social and environmental well-being? 4. How consumer cooperatives improve members' livelihoods, to keep in line with the introduction section.

Regarding the study interviews, it is unclear whether the calibres (interviewees) were asked specific or general questions. Additional information would be needed to determine the nature of the interview questions. To further understand the impact of consumer cooperatives on members' livelihoods, evaluate how these findings can be implemented in Ethiopia. The authors stated in the opening section that Ethiopia's consumer cooperatives have unique challenges, such as inadequate infrastructure, low literacy rates, and poor financial management, so the study must address the points raised in the introduction.
