

## Review of: "Death of English and the Language of the Internet: Mistakes and Errors"

In his article "Death of English and the Language of the Internet: Mistakes and Errors", the author addresses how the combination of Communicative Language Teaching and use of social media may be detrimental to the perceived quality of students' academic writing. A comprehensive description of the development of ELT in India and the progression towards CLT in that country is provided as background. The topic of emojis, albeit interesting and relevant to social media, seems a bit divergent since emojis play no role in the analyzed texts. The overall methodology is reasonable and the presented results appear to support the author's premise.

This article is interesting, timely, and relevant. However, I recommend reducing the emoji references to essential information. The underlying premise could be stated more prominently in the abstract and introduction.
