The article gives a general overview of this approach for mosquito-borne disease control, but not specifically about Indonesia as the title says. Inter-, trans-, multidisciplinary, and multi-sectoral approaches are discussed well, but more emphasis should have been given to active surveillance. Furthermore, some more citations should be added, as a lot of studies were undertaken globally during and post-COVID-19 on active surveillance. Some recent statistical data may be added for analysis, the major component missing in the article. Two figures are given in the article, but without any source/reference/legend. These should be added to avoid any plagiarism issues. Some of the information is being repeated, and many grammatical errors need to be looked into. Needs modification by incorporating the above suggestions.
