In this statement, "If patients are encouraged to share their lived experience, it becomes easier for the clinician to **join the dots**", which may allow the diagnosis of a neurodivergent condition to surface from what may have previously appeared to be a random collection of unrelated symptoms." Kindly use the word "**connecting the dots**"

In this statement, "If we are to become more effective at managing these conditions, breaking down barriers between services for physical and mental health would be a great help." I felt, along with physical and mental health, **good social well-being** can also be the important part for overall health of the patient.
