A monoclonal antibody directed against the human T-cell-expressed receptor cytotoxic T-lymphocyte-associated antigen 4 (CT LA4; CT LA-4), with potential immune checkpoint inhibitory and antineoplastic activities. Upon administration, anti-CT LA-4 monoclonal antibody BCD-145 targets and binds to CT LA-4 expressed on T-cells and inhibits the CT LA-4-mediated downregulation of T-cell activation. This leads to a cytotoxic T-lymphocyte (CT L)-mediated immune response against cancer cells. CT LA-4, an inhibitory receptor and member of the immunoglobulin superfamily (IgSF), plays a key role in the downregulation of the immune system.
