However, the theoretical proposal turns out to be novel for the proposed case. However, it is not possible to "normalize" when in Colombia there is a complex social, cultural and even productive diversity from the Hass avocado producing regions. Case happened in Salamina cannot be replicated for the rest of Colombia.
