Also, the paper will look beneficial if the authors show in the Conclusion section how the discussion or argument has been resolved, and the connection of the conclusion to the introduction creates a sense of completeness. If in the Conclusion section, the influence of the paper is mentioned for policymakers, it also must be clearly expressed in the Introduction sections, a some of the aims.

In the Limitation and Recommendation sections, the authors used in-text references, in my opinion, these sections should effectively provide the main ideas connected with the research in order to leave a lasting impression on the reader.
