

Review of: "[Case Report] Profound Symptom Alleviation in Long-Covid Patients After PAMP-Immunotherapy: Three Case Reports"

This article submitted by Gaudek and colleagues reports on three cases, where LC patients were treated with PAMP-Immunotherapy and experienced remarkable alleviation of their symptoms.

These observations sound very interesting and require definitely detailed investigation, especially with regards to alterations of the immunological equilibrium and shift of immune cells polarization by PAMP-Immunotherapy.

However, a plenty of details are missing such as the description of the PAMP-containing drug and clear patient demographics (but please in an anonymized manner). It is not clear to the Reviewer if the patients treated with PAMPs were cancer patients and suffered additionally of LC. Then the observed effects would be an incidental finding. If the patients were no cancer patients that rationale for performing this therapeutic approach is missing.

Language: In gerneral. language is acceptable. However, the writing style is quite unscientific. This should be adjusted.

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
