

Review of: "The Cost of Being a Celebrity on Mental Health"

This work explores the challenges associated with celebrity status from a mental health point of view. First of all, I would like to congratulate the author on this peculiar research. The manuscript is quite interesting and has some value.

I would just like to make a few observations and suggestions for the author to contemplate:

1. In the *Introduction*, some interviews conducted by the author are mentioned but no reference was subsequently made to them.
2. The manuscript should include a more detailed analysis of how mental health is affected by celebrity status.
3. The number of references is a bit few. In my opinion, there should be at least thirty.
4. It is not very clear what the contribution of the paper is. An expansion of the research's scope and aims would enhance reader understanding.
5. In the end, perhaps it can be useful to include a short paragraph in which limitations and future developments are provided.
6. The last comment concerns the use of the first person throughout the manuscript; it may be better to make the entire text impersonal.

Finally, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to review and comment on this research, and I think addressing the aspects mentioned above can strengthen this investigation.
