The paper quality is good but needs improvement. I try not to repeat comments earlier expressed.

The data related to cancer-resulted death in India and worldwide makes it easy to understand the essence of the topic. But the reader wants to read what the authors want to say by those data. The interpretation should follow some exact claims as well.

Regarding Traditional Medicine, the authors need to clarify whether it is really traditional medicine. If the enrichment of some compounds in those extracts "flows up" in the context, they are modern approaches. If not, the authors should discuss possible side effects that could result from other major compounds probably involved in those extracts. These two points will serve to improve the paper quality as well.

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
