The authors made a good effort to understand the overweight/obesity scenario among Nigerian married women and this work will be helpful to others. The following specific comments may be addressed to improve the manuscript.

- 1. What is the logic behind taking the hypothesis 'the Southern region will have a higher burden of overnutrition compared to the Northern region'? It needs to be clarified in the last paragraph of the Introduction Section.
- 2. It would be better to represent the spatial variation of overweight/obesity among Nigerian women by a map, which will be more informative and understandable to any reader.
- 3. The manuscript could be more interesting if you give more insights about the variations existing between northern and southern regions in terms of overweight/obesity.
