Both the objectives and the methodological design with its instruments for the collection and analysis of the information are pertinent and adequate.

A greater organisation in the presentation of the results is requested. They should be clearer as to which objectives they respond to and, especially, the order of these, in order to add coherence and order to the results.

It would be advisable to greatly improve the quality of the images. They are not well visualised, they are blurred.
