The subject that is clarified in the Unravelling The Contributions Of The Nigerian Livestock And Other More Prominent Sectors In Mitigation Of Global Green House Gas (GHG) is very actual at that time but needs some improvement in order to be published:

1. I did not find your method for solving the problem in a straightforward and coherent way,
2. I think Green House Gas (GHG) in Nigeria should be analyzed together with food security problems because the most important is to supply food for people.
3. Some deeper analyses referred to the Green House Gas (GHG) in Nigeria could be performed, for example, what part of it is the emission to supply basic life needs and what for example to produce other goods. I do not think that Green House Gas (GHG) emissions in Nigeria should be cut drastically in Nigeria without taking into consideration the living conditions there. China for example has introduced a plan to cut emissions for about 30 years, ... including an emission rise in the first years.
4. The abstract should be structured in the proper way, for example: Context, Objective, Methods, Results and conclusions, Significance:
5. The paper should be structured like one of the other reviewers mentioned before (1. Introduction; covering research problem and objective research work, chapter 2. literature reviews, 3. methodology, 4 analysis and findings, and the conclusion and perhaps 5 recommendations). Not like project report format.

The problem is worth doing research, but the Author needs to rework the entire paper to give it a proper journal paper structure.
