- * The title should be reframe (Do not use punctuation marks in title),
- * Email address, Orchid number should be added under the author's name,
- *Abstract part: Results and the used method should be mentioned briefly in the abstract part.
- * Keywords: Please remove Coronavirus and student satisfaction,
- * List of abbreviations is not needed.
- * The pertinence of the sample for the research purpose, and selection bias should be clearly stated,
- * The problem statement should be clear and well-articulated, and the research question should be clearly stated,
- * The literature should be critically evaluated, gaps in the literature should be identified on the basis of the study,
- *Research methodology should be added. Put all research methods related into one part, namely "Research Methods."

 The research methods should be added and sufficiently detailed to provide transparency,
- *The characteristics of the researchers that may affect the research during data collection should be defined and adequately explained,
- * Findings should be placed in the context of relevant literature, and alternative interpretations should be considered when needed,
- *Fair conclusion without sufficient justification from evidence presented,
- * Discussion part should be added,
- * The plagiarism of the article is checked on Turnitin program and the report is 85% which is too high,
