However, the authors are encouraged to go through the comments below (in addition to those on the main document; see attachment in the supplementary data section) to improve the quality of the manuscript.

Abstract

The method section must be reformulated to include the evaluated parameters.

Introduction

- 1. The rationale of the study is not really captured.
- 2. In terms of formatting, this section should be re-arranged into a maximum of 3-4 paragraphs.

Results

- 1. The data presented as frequency should be in ratio form (X/total).
- 2. Tables 1 and 2 results are poorly commented. The authors should review the comments to be representative of the data presented in the tables.
- 3. In Table 3, the column 'No' is not clear; do explain well what it is about.

Discussion

The English of the first paragraph should be reviewed.
