**Abstract:** The abstract offers a concise summary of the study's aims, outcomes, and approaches. However, it would be better to expand a bit on the analyzed data.

**Introduction & Literature Review:** Need improvement especially in Literature review. In my view, the definitions of terms (section 5) should have been included in Introduction (section 1). The literature review seems to be missing a coherent theme that connects all the references and highlights the research gap.

**Objectives:** The objectives were appropriate to the study.

**Methodology:** The data analysis procedures for both qualitative and quantitative methods are not adequately addressed in this section.

## **Result & Discussion:**

- 1. Structuring this section around the three research questions would enhance its value and readability.
- 2. Presenting the sociodemographic data results in a table format would be convenient for readers.
- 3. In my opinion, the results do not adequately explain the faculty's perception (objective 1 & 2).
- 4. The content of this section was briefly written and requires further discussion of the findings.

**Conclusion:** The last sentence appears to be incomplete. "Furthermore, it may be critical to the university to design standards, procedures, and regulations for promoting digital ....????"
