Thank you for your work, it is my pleasure to read and review your work. While I believe your work has provided an academic contribution to the growing e-government literature, there have been several major inputs to increase the quality for publication.

First, as this paper seeks to re-define the concept of e-government, I believe the literature that you have curated are insufficient to back your argument of the concept being underrepresented in literature. I believe that adding more literature, particularly if you can distinguish them based on several main characteristics i.e. the knowledge sources that imply the differences between Global North-Global South experiences in implementing e-government, will improve the quality.

Secondly, you need to explore the methodology to suffice the information on how this study is produced. Bibliometrics and systematic literature review are among those methods that will be beneficial for your study.

Thirdly, the discussion section is rather lacking of findings and how they go back to the theoretical framework that you have made. Please consider adding more thorough explanations on this section.

Next, the conclusion also lacks of more explanations. The summary of findings and how it answers the proposed research question should be elaborated, before you acknowledge more on the study limitations and what to do next.

In summary, I suggest that you work on major revisions that you made before the editor can accept it in the publications.
