Dear author, I have gone through your manuscript "Effect of supplementation with *Moringa oleifera* on antioxidant and oxidative stress biomarkers of infertile women: a pilot open-label case-control randomized clinical study" and found a few things to be revised.

The manuscript is quite interesting and presents a lot of valuable information. The topic of research is quite relevant and sensitive, i.e., infertility in women, but the introduction lacks clarity and a continuous flow of information. The flow of information needs to be more like a story. Replace old references with new publications. Follow a uniform style of citation, brackets, et al., etc. Italicization of scientific names is missing in the whole manuscript. Diction should be focused. The concluding paragraph needs to be improved further. Instead of N for numbers, n should be preferred. Repetition should be avoided in the abstract, conclusion, and introduction. Results of the hormonal study are missing in the manuscript, and a table should be designed accordingly.
