It includes: IIA (T2a, N0, M0); IIA1 (T2a1, N0, M0); IIA2 (T2a2, N0, M0); IIB (T2b, N0, M0); T2: Cervical carcinoma invades beyond uterus but not to pelvic wall or to lower third of vagina. T2a: Tumor without parametrial invasion. T2a1: Clinically visible lesion 4.0 cm or less in greatest dimension. T2a2: Clinically visible lesion more than 4.0 cm in greatest dimension. T2b: Tumor with parametrial invasion. N0: No regional lymph node metastasis. M0: No distant metastasis. (partially adapted from AJCC)
