

Review of: "Effect of Supplementation with Moringa Oleifera on Antioxidant and Oxidative Stress Biomarkers of Infertile Women: A Pilot Open-Label Case-Control Randomized Clinical Study"

For an overall evaluation, I consider the paper well-written and much of it well described. Therefore, this work is a good contribution to the scientific community. But, before accepting it, some revisions are necessary.

- Authors must spell "Moringa oleifera" correctly throughout the text (italics, only the first word beginning with a capital letter).
- In at least the first mention of Moringa, the author must include the first author to describe this plant (Moringa oleifera Lamarck or Moringa oleifera Lam.).
- In the first paragraph of the introduction, recent data (last three years) on infertility is required.
- In table 01, it is important to use the same number of significant figures in the data. For example, 17.88 ± 9.28 should become 17.9 ± 9.28 to maintain 3 significant figures. The same suggestion applies to table 2.

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
