- A) Abstract needs to be improved by adding some information on the objectives of the study. The methods need to elaborate on number of participants, FGD and how to analyze the data.
- B) In the introduction there is no information related to current knowledge on the prevention of children's sexual harassment in Indonesia and other world. There is no review on the barrier and facilitator factors of the current strategies to prevent children's sexual harassment. There is no information on other studies related with the topic of the research.
- c) the study has no grand theory underpinning the study. There is no basic knowledge or theory to develop the concept of preventing children's sexual harassment, to be integrated between the state, community's and the family.
- d) in the methods, there is no information on how many informants and participants for FGD, how the authors select or recruited the informant/participants of the study, how the FGD and in-depth interview occurs. how the data collected. how to analyze data, how to ensure rigors and what is the methods of analyzed data was taken.
- e) in result, the finding is not clear how the data from informant, FGD and observation is combined, and used to improve the quality of the data.
- f) Since the study will be related with the many actors, the recommendation needs to be related here is a need on how to implement the ideas.
