To enhance clarity for the reader, I recommend including all three major objectives in the research objective section.

Regarding the results, I acknowledge that they primarily address the factors contributing to housing challenges in Uganda. Nonetheless, readers expect the paper to cover all research objectives. Therefore, I suggest splitting the results into three parts based on the objectives of the research.

I encourage the author to provide a more detailed explanation of the research methodology. This would help clarify the connection between the methodology and the results, providing a better alignment with the research goals.
