- 1. The problem must be further justified, and the gap in the literature review must be clearly presented. The authors argue that: This paper fills the gap by examining the key research question of 'entrepreneurship and its efficacies towards economic and social progress in the presence of uncertainties due to inequality and radicalism'. Unfortunately, the results of the literature are not discussed. Moreover, the choices made need to be justified.
- 2. The literature review should clarify the concepts used. On the other hand, the literature review should show the link between the variables used.
- 3. In the methodology, the authors should specify how the variables were operationalised (are the variables taken from existing measurement scales or were they developed by the authors). They should also specify the statistical tests carried out and justify them.
- 4. The discussion of the results can be strengthened; the main results should be compared with the results of previous work in order to show similarities and differences.
