Dear authors,

The paper has great potential as its topic is interesting and "hot". Nevertheless, I think it should be improved a lot in all its parts. Here are some comments which I hope will be useful to improve the manuscript.

- The abstract, introduction and literature review sections are too long and need reorganization. I suggest merging the
 introduction and literature review sections, maintaining only the parts that are useful to understand the research
 objectives.
- In my opinion, as presented now the manuscript does not fill the gaps presented in the introduction. The questionnaires and the questions of the interviews are not reported as well as their answer. They are the most interesting part of the research and should be highly valorised and will probably help to reach the research objectives.
- One problem is that the target population of the study are the employees of three ministries, and it seems that the quantitative analysis is based on their opinions, which are very likely biased. I am also a bit sceptical about the econometric model used. I am not an expert and the data used were not specified, but the selection of the variables is dubious. The dependent variable "Climate change and sustainable development" is too vague. Some further clarifications on these issues are necessary.
- Usually, the conclusion is the last part, and the acknowledgement section is composed of a few short sentences.
