

Review of: "Analytical Study and Amelioration of Plastic Pavement Material Quality"

The article deals with pertinent issues on sustainability and the potential reuse of plastic materials. The paper is generally well-written and acceptable for publication with minor corrections.

- Figure 1 is not very clear and is rather hazy. The authors can find alternative images and reference these if they have been uplifted from some other source.
- How were the specimens prepared? It might be useful to indicate the dimensions of the specimens for the different tests.
- The results and discussion sections are lacking in the aspect of discussion. The authors presented the results and described them but did not provide adequate discussions to explain the trends and how these results compared with those of other researchers.
- Comparison with pavements from Cameroon included only the compressive strength test. What about the other parameters such as flexural strength, porosity? Are these properties not as important in the end use? It might be misleading to only look at one parameter where the specimens produced performed better than the pavements manufactured in Cameroon. Would it not have been helpful rather to compare to set standards for pavements used worldwide?
