Under this section, the readership may want to know when the search was carried out, why only two databases were searched, and what the exclusion criteria was. Furthermore, the methodology should be clear as to what information was extracted from each article and how many people extracted the information. Readers may also want to know if information was extracted independently if there were more than one reviewer who extracted the information.

Under results, the authors should inform the readers about the number of articles that were included in the review, and the characteristics of the included studies.

Finally, the authors should be consistent in the way they write words in the manuscript. The use tele medicine and tele-medicine, as well as low-income countries and developing countries interchangeably.
