

Review of: "Efficacy of Anogeissus leiocarpus as a Therapeutic Agent for Some Pathogenic Bacteria"

I won't find any kind of novelty in this manuscript as the same kind of work was already published entitled **"Phytochemical and antibacterial screening of Anogeissus leiocarpus against some microorganisms associated with infectious wounds"** authored by Abdullahi Mann et al. in 2008.

Spelling mistakes are observed in the manuscript. For example, in the title, leiocarpus is mentioned, but in the abstract, it is mentioned as leocarpus (the i is missing)

Subheadings are not appropriate (like in the methodology, Bacteria species, The extracts phytochemical qualitative analysis)

Proximate composition and mineral analysis assay was carried out by AOAC: but the AOAC edition, AOAC test method number, and instruments used are not mentioned. The methodology is not clear.

The antibacterial test of plant extract in the manuscript is not clear.

In the results, table No. 2 is not formulated properly. Results have to be rewritten.

Photos or plates representing the inhibition zone are not depicted in the manuscript.

Some references are missing, like Malinowska et al. 2020 in the text, but in the reference, it is mentioned as Malinowska P 2013.

Sentences in the whole manuscript are not justified.

Overall, the manuscript needs a lot of modification with attention before publishing.
