There are certain areas of concern in this research paper-

- 1. The title should be concerned with perception of teachers as that is what this research paper intends to present.

- 2. Introduction needs to be concise. Citations are missing in introduction. Introduction needs to be more concise and less descriptive.
- 3. Discussion is missing altogether. There are some works if not many, on application of TBLT on students from diverse subjects. Citation and cross citations is absent.
- 4. After results analysis the researchers conclude abruptly. There needs to be a proper discussion, conclusion, limitations and suggestions for implementing TBLT in B.Tech classrooms.
