The paper tackles an important topic and provides a good overview over a large body of recent literature. Here are some suggestions to further improve the paper:

- 1. The paper is quite long for being called "a brief summary". To improve clarity, I suggest to present the structure of the paper more clearly and to cut superfluous material (e.g., Section 2 is not the core of the paper but can feel exhausting to read due to its length).
- 2. I would have appreciated more concrete info and a concise summarization of literature's take on effective prompting.
- 3. Language could overall be further improved. In particular, avoid sensationalist language (such as "mind-blowing").
