Here are some of the comments I should forward to the authors:

1. Title - It is better to say hyperlipidemia/dyslipidemia instead of high lipid profile.
2. Abstract (Results part) - What is dyslipidemia medicine? Better to rename it as lipid-lowering medications.
3. The study setting, Johns Hopkins (Saudi Arabia), should be included in the Key Words section.
4. In the inclusion criteria, what does "greater than 20 years" mean? Were all patients > 20 years of age included in the study regardless of their dyslipidemia status?
5. Results - There are many misunderstandings; try to revise it (e.g., first line of results part).
6. In the results and discussion parts, there is overlapping in the boundary of the text and table; the tables have overshadowed many parts of the text. Try to fix it accordingly.
