This manuscript has some significant impacts and can contribute to science. However, there are several points which authors should improve before considering it for acceptance.

General Comments

This scientific paper is quite interesting to publish. However, there are some major changes that need to be rewritten by the author. The method is the key to seeing the validity in revealing research results. For this reason, the author needs to work hard to improve and detail each chapter or sub-chapter of this scientific manuscript.

- 1. Extensive English editing is required.
- 2. Lack of Clarity: The title is quite long and complex, making it challenging to grasp the main focus of the study at a glance.
- 3. Incomplete Information: In the abstract, add 2-3 sentences of key methods that are important for readers to immediately understand this research.
- 4. Lengthy Phrasing: Some sentences in the abstract are quite lengthy and could be structured more succinctly for better readability.

Introduction

- 5. The introduction part is quite weak; add more literature to highlight the importance of your study.
- 6. Support from Prior Studies: Some of the citations provided in the introduction lack motivation, making it challenging for readers to assess the recency and relevance of these studies.
- 7. Lack of Specificity: Some of the details tend to be overly general and lack specific details about the study's findings and their implications.
- 10. Lack of Future Directions: The section does not provide insights into potential avenues for future research or experimentation based on the study's outcomes.
