

# Review of: "Challenges and Prospects of Aerosol-Cloud-Precipitation Studies Over Africa"

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Authors evaluate the status of the research on aerosol-cloud-precipitation interaction in Africa. They reviewed past studies and analyzed challenges surrounding this area of research.

A few remarks:

- This sentence can be deleted: p. 8, "Knippertz et al. (2015) gave an overview of the funding and participants of the DACCWA project."
- This sentence can be deleted: p. 9, "See Section 2a of the original article for a description of TRMM and MODIS datasets. Adapted from (Adebiyi et al., 2023)"
- Something is missing in this sentence (second paragraph, p. 9): "Instrument malfunctions, calibration problems, or logistical constraints can lead to data collection, reducing the reliability of observations during field campaigns."
- Authors have outlined international collaborations through various projects. But intra-African collaboration is not analyzed. Where do you put south/south collaboration? How is the collaboration between state agencies and universities/researchers? What about networking? Is WASCAL playing any role?
- What efforts are being done to resolve the hurdles mentioned in the paper, and what are the prospects in this field?
