

Review of: "Biodiversity, Anthropogenic"

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This article deals with an important issue, namely the role of indigenous peoples in preserving biodiversity, notably through the domestication of wild species. It describes the domestication process and the genetic preservation of the breeds created. To this end, the author draws on an abundant bibliography (54 references) and concludes with recommendations. However, although the article is very interesting, it should more clearly state its objective of establishing a state of the art. I also recommend announcing not only the purpose of the article, but also the plan followed right from the introduction. It would also be interesting to justify this article with the author's two research experiences in India, concerning rice varieties on the one hand, and forest peoples on the other, which led her to present this broad synthesis. And to conclude, what does this broadening of her focus of reflection bring her in relation to her previous research?
