Following my assessment based on the STROBE checklist, I noted the following observations in the reviewed paper.

Firstly, it is suggested to add "Cross-sectional Study (Feb-Apr 2022)" to the title. This addition will help readers understand the study's design and timeframe before reading the research paper.

Secondly, it is recommended that the author cite credible sources in the abstract and introduction sections to provide information on puerperium complications (30 to 50%). Additionally, the paper lacks details about healthy participants. Therefore, the methodology requires more description of how healthy participants were selected and their characteristics. This information would increase transparency and strengthen the study's rigor. However, the study's objective is effectively articulated, highlighting a significant knowledge gap regarding purpura complications in this context.
