Let me start by saying that the study is original and promising. First of all, the phrase "Pandora Box" should be changed to "Pandora's Box" if it is to be kept in the title.

Although the article title is designed to be attractive, it is difficult for researchers to access the article based on keywords. Therefore, a title compatible with the content would be appropriate.

It would be more appropriate to design the abstract section concisely as subject, aim, literature gap, data-method-findings, evaluation, and implication for future studies.

The objectives in the introduction and abstract sections should overlap with each other.

The design of the article sections is a bit complicated. It would be useful to subject this to traditional ordering.

The conclusion section should also be designed to include findings in tables, for example, instead of general statements.
