I also believe that they should include a contextualisation of the health professions in Nigeria and the professional competencies of each health profession.

I consider the sample of physiotherapists and dieticians and dentists to be insufficient to be able to extrapolate the results to the population.

It would be necessary to indicate the date of approval and the registration number of the approval of the ethics committee
