Some minor revisions are suggested:

I have some doubts regarding the type of study. Is it merely a study design outline? Is it still a pilot study? Since there are no results or conclusions, I assume it is still in the design phase.

The title should be clearer and should exactly state the methodology besides "qualitative descriptive study"...

The abstract should be reviewed, as after reading it, I still had doubts regarding the methodology.

Regarding the introduction, it seems well-structured, as well as the description of the methodology throughout the text.

The Key Questions were well thought out and seem very relevant. I would add, what training have they done in the area to make them feel like experts? And what would they do to increase people's literacy?

Regarding bias, several issues arise. The use of interviews may limit participant responses; they may be inclined to answer what is socially accepted and known rather than what they do in their clinical practice. Have measures been considered to reduce these biases?

I think the sample is small.
