You need language editing to revise some spaces, grammar issues, usse of captal and small letters, some paragraphs are small i.e. paragraph 7 and 8 under introduction. More references may be need in the first part of the introduction. The results in Table 1 have also been repeated text above it. It would be proper to leave it as text. Remove Figure 1. Just present in text the % increase.
