The article primarily synthesizes existing research findings without introducing novel insights or original contributions to the discourse. Consequently, it cannot significantly advance knowledge or offer fresh perspectives regarding climate change adaptation in Egypt's agricultural and energy sectors.

The absence of a comprehensive methodology section obscures critical aspects of the research process, including data collection, analysis, and interpretation methodologies. This shortage of transparency impedes the assessment of the study's validity and reliability. Additionally, the article lacks a clearly defined research question or set of objectives, leaving readers uncertain about the specific aspects of climate change adaptation it aims to investigate or elucidate. This ambiguity compromises the coherence of the paper and undermines its overall relevance and significance.

The reliance on outdated references suggests a limited engagement with recent developments in the field of climate change adaptation.

The article deviates from established scientific reporting conventions by omitting essential sections such as an introduction and a detailed methodology. This departure from standard journal formatting detracts from the paper's suitability for publication in scholarly journals.
