The article is a clear, well-constructed text, with a well-developed theoretical argument. The abstract is clear and precise on the topic of the article, with correct keywords. Separate mention of the figures (maps) and selected phrases (news type). Both types of figures are very well designed. In short, a good article that should be revised (some commas are repeated), but with good writing and a very interesting analysis of the topic.
