## *Reviewer Feedback*

My greetings to the author; academic work cannot be mature unless it is submitted for review in its best shape. Following my reading of the manuscript, I have various observations to make about this work, including the following:

**1- Study Design:** I am unable to classify the study as original research or a review study because it did not adhere to a certain style.

**2- Study Area:** You will still require assistance to determine if this study belongs in the economics or computer science fields after reading it.

**3- Title:** The manuscript's body and substance do not match the title; therefore, I suggest changing it to a more specific one.

**4- Abstract:** Due to its importance to readers, this part needed extra consideration. I felt that the author here failed to use the appropriate style of abstract writing. In addition to employing difficult terminology in the abstract, the author includes a lot of questions without giving any explanations. Due to the unclear abstract, it produced, the study's ability to be quickly understood was compromised. The only way to fix this is to completely rewrite the abstract.

**5- Theoretical framework:** Here, the author gave a number of items with a focus on various AI domains that, in his or her opinion, constitute the solution. To make the study more clear, I guess these terms should be mentioned in the title. The same reference is used by the authors many times in one paragraph! This is not your typical academic essay. It is preferable to quote the same source only once in a paragraph.

**6- Conclusions:** A conclusion could not be reached by writing general knowledge, opinions, and statements. Furthermore, the study merely makes fresh suggestions or supports earlier research. Given several claims that are made in this section, I suppose the author needs to reevaluate it.

The study sheds light on potential ethical difficulties that may occur if AI applications become heavily integrated into our lives in the predicted future, even though it did not contribute any new themes or offer a solution to the existing problem.
