I think the author did a great job pointing out the challenges faced in the field of education at all levels due to the technology advancement. However, I expected to read how/what technological advancement affected Zambia rather than the general issues addressed in the article. Therefore, the author may need to focus on how these challenges have impacted/are impacting teaching and learning in Zambia. I would recommend a major revision of this article to be considered for acceptance. The author needs to cite more research studies focusing on Zambia education.

In addition, the author needs to clarify the goal of this article and identify a proper method to achieve his/her research goal. The current writing is more like an informal essay, rather than an academic research paper. This article needs to follow an appropriate format with all required sections included. The current version only includes introduction and conclusion.

Overall, the topic is interesting, and the concern is real. Yet a major revision is needed.

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
