

Review of: "Factors Associated with Contraceptive Use Among Migrant Female Head Porters in the Kumasi Metropolis"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

Introduction: Great work outlining the importance of your work. Excellent description of female head porters. Consider reworking the last paragraph of the introduction to restate the aim/objectives of your paper rather than citing other papers that have done similar studies.

Methods: Very clear and concise.

Results: Very interesting results. The results section should focus on just reporting the results, not interpreting them. For example, consider moving the following sentences to the discussion ("This exposes the vulnerability of female head porters to the risks of unplanned pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases.").

Discussion: It would be helpful to specify which ethic groups you are specifically referring to in the following sentences: "There is great importance attached to having a large family size among most ethnic groups in northern Ghana where these head porters originate from. As a result, couples do not plan their family size nor practice contraception." The paragraph on health insurance could use additional citations to back up what you are claiming. It would be important to specify that the multiple sexual partners and contraception use were positively correlated instead of just stating related ("The results are interesting because contraceptive use was strongly related to having multiple sexual partners").

Conclusion: This sentence does not make sense as is, please revisit ("Researchers have paid more attention to the livelihoods and living conditions of female head porters to the neglect of their reproductive and sexual health issues.)
