

Review of: "Antimicrobial Ayurveda Crops as Superfoods for Export, Conservation & Farmers' Benefit"

The topic addressed in this review is rather interesting, yet it severely lacks in two major points:

- 1) In the Methodology section, there is no indication of the criteria employed by the authors regarding the health benefits of the herbs. The authors should also extend the reported articles concerning the phytochemical characterization of the botanicals of interest; TPC is too restrictive given these plants' bioactivity;
- 2) It is nowadays accepted that the benefit of bioactive molecules is not just due to their antioxidant potential but mainly to their receptorial activity. Therefore, I suggest to the authors that they reassess this paper taking this into account.
