4. The objective of the paper presented needs clarifications to help the reader understand the main idea of the paper, especially for the study case.
5. Facts and figures are missing throughout the paper. Authors need to incorporate these facts in the intro section.
6. Authors should follow the research paper pattern in writing section names, headings, subheadings, and the scheme of the paper. Avoid unnecessary headings.
7. Authors should not add unnecessary tables in the appendix section.
8. Needs serious formatting in font, line spacing, and table setting.
9. Please read the latest relevant papers from high-impact factor journals, adopt their scholarly way of analyzing data, and write your conclusion. Throughout the article, the authors need to add recent research.
10. The authors need to add limitations of the study in the conclusion part.

It seems to be the first draft of a paper. Authors need to consider the mentioned points. Serious attention is required. Moreover, a second revision is necessary.
