The article is short but sufficient to articulate its arguments. It tackles the concept of Sovereignty, considering foreign interventions as a source of change. While the author makes sound analysis, what is lacking is an explanation of how the intervention changed sovereignty perception in both Serbia and Kosovo, and how the 1999 intervention can be analysed considering the perception of sovereignty by the Kurti government.
