Actually, I found it really interesting that, even if almost half of the patients were under thirty years of age, the association has been associated with the number of deliveries and not with the older ages.

I'd be interested also in knowing the incidence and the type of perineal lacerations at delivery and, if possible, the repair of them, if done.

Moreover, it would be notably useful to expand the questionnaire in order to investigate the kind of alimentary habits of these women and if this could relate to hemorrhoids.

Not having this data, incidence in urban and rural populations could be investigated, assuming that city environments could relate to a less healthy diet.
