Unfortunately not much novelty was found in the results of this study. The results showed that the HIV-infected women who were the sample of the study occurred several cases of Hepatitis B coinfection and the risk factors were free sex behavior, lack of hepatitis B vaccination, lack of knowledge, blood transfusion and organ transplantation. This has been widely reported in several previous studies conducted in several countries. However, I think this research is still important to be published so that the people, especially the people in Ogun State, Nigeria, understand the health problems in their area. In addition, it is hoped that the local government can make efforts to suppress cases of HIV-Hepatitis B in the area.

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
