This manuscript describes the effects of wet cupping therapy on some inflammatory factors in patients affected by non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD): A quasi-experimental trial study with self-controls, there are several major flaws as follows:

- 1. The sample size (the total number of patients) participated in this quasi-experimental study with self-control as mentioned at (2.1. Subjects) section is (16 cases) is considered small. At the same time the actual number of cases mentioned in table (1) is (15 cases) only.
- 2. The time interval between zero time and first session must be mentioned exactly as it will affect the length of the study if it is thirty days or forty-five days.
- 3. The details of the statistical program used must be mentioned.
- 4. A parametric test of significance should be selected.
- 5. A measure of variability as standard error or standard deviation of the population must be calculated to set inferential statistics rather than using percentage.
- 6. The results and discussion sections should be presented more clearly.
- 7. There are several grammatical errors. The authors are strongly advised to consult an expert in English editing.
